

# Co-production Training

## Session Outline

An interactive workshop session enabling participants to better understand co-production and how to apply it within their work or engagement activities. To gain more confidence in delivering in a co-produced way. The course is provided in a mixed participant setting meaning people with lived-experience and staff are working together.

- Have the skills and confidence to be able to apply co-production to their work (measure – feedback)
- We will see an increase in co-production activity (measure – number of the engagement activities)
