The Medical Education Research Forum (MERF) is held every four months and is a Deanery acknowledged dedicated & mandatory forum for Higher Trainees. It is also attended by other trainees & trainers who are interested in Research.

MRCPsych Course

The Postgraduate Certificate (PGCert), Diploma (PGDip) and the Masters (MSc) in Psychiatry have been developed as part of the Clinical Specialties Programme within Brighton and Sussex Medical School and are jointly validated by the University of Brighton and the University of Sussex. The courses are designed for part-time study.

The MSc course provides the opportunity for students to gain academic qualifications at Postgraduate level and have a structured research experience. All CT1s are expected to enrol on Brighton and Sussex Medical School's Postgraduate Certificate in Psychiatry which will be fully funded by HEKSS.

KMPT provide regular teaching on a Thursday which is exam focussed and relevant to the different papers. Trainees also have CASC practice and CASC Mock exams which are excellent preparation tools and all trainees are encouraged to attend from the start of core training.
